Heifer Show

Purebred Heifer Entries -\$75 per entry

1. Papers and tattoo will be checked
2. Breed Classes (minimum of 5 head entered to make a breed class, if that is not met they will be placed in Other Breeds)
3. Champion and Reserve Breed winners compete for Grand Champion Purebred Heifer
4. Champion and Reserve Purebred Heifer receive Trophy Buckles and will compete for Overall Champion Female

Commercial Heifer Entries - \$75 per entry

1. Divided by age Classes into Junior and Senior Divisions
2. Champion and Reserve in Junior and Senior Divisions compete for overall Commercial Female
3. Champion and Reserve Commercial Heifer receive Trophy Buckles and will compete for Overall Champion Female

Overall Female

1. Champion and Reserve Purebred and Champion and Reserve Commercial will compete for Overall Female
2. Overall Champion Female will receive a unique Champion Buckle.

Steer Show

Entry Fee \$75/head

1. Classes split by Weight, Shown from lightest to heaviest
2. Champion and Reserve Receive Trophy Buckles

Showmanship

Automatic Entry for each Participant

Non Participant Entry Fee \$75, Non Participants must find an animal to borrow for showmanship.

Ages: as of January 1, 2019

Peewee – 8 & under

Junior – 9-12

Intermediate - 13-15

Senior – 16-21

1. Trophy Buckles will be awarded to each age category Champion and Reserve Showman



General Rules and Regulations

1. ***This is a FAMILY EVENT. The objective is to work together as a family and help your children when necessary. WE STRONGLY ENCOURAGE only juniors doing the grooming/fitting of their animals. If they need help by all means help them, but we discourage adults doing everything for them. This event is learning opportunity for youth.***
2. The Medicine Hat Exhibition and the Cody Sibbald Legacy Classic Committee are not responsible for any accident, injury or damage suffered to person or property while at the show and grounds. Participants and their exhibits enter the show at their own risk.
3. Only mailed in entries will be accepted. Email and fax entries will not be accepted.
4. Livestock on the grounds must have a CCIA tag.
5. Show is open to ages 21 and under, as of January 1, 2019.
6. Purebred papers and tattoo's will be checked.
7. Cattle may only be shown in one division.
8. No animals with ringworm or any other contagious diseases will be allowed on the grounds.
9. Shavings will be initially provided.
10. If you require extra power please bring a generator.
11. All Steers and Heifers must be born in 2018 and must be halter broke.
12. No animal shall be considered by the judge in awarding of prizes unless the exhibitors show number is conspicuously displayed.
13. No tampering or altering livestock in any way will be tolerated.
14. Purebred classes will follow breed specific rules. Purebred animal entries must be accompanied by a purebred registration paper. Registered percentage heifers can ONLY be entered in the commercial heifer show.
15. All rules and complaints will be left to the discretion of the show committee to make the final decision.
16. The show is open to all but the committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
